



## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

NYS DOT Region 1 - Route 146 over the Mohawk River Design Build Project is in Rexford NY, also known as the Rexford Bridge. The new Rexford Bridge is a \$32.5 million design-build project to build a new bridge carrying State Route 146 over the Mohawk River between the towns of Clifton Park in Saratoga County and Niskayuna in Schenectady County.

This Design Build Project includes replacement of the existing 1964 two-lane steel truss Rexford Bridge with a four-lane steel girder bridge over the Mohawk River between Schenectady and Saratoga Counties. The work also includes replacing one signalized intersection with a 2-lane Roundabout, reconstructing and widening another signalized intersection, installation of four large culverts, and reconstructing and widening to 4-lanes a  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile section of Route 146.

The project also includes building a bicycle/pedestrian path between Riverview Road and the Mohawk-Hudson Bike-Hike Trail. RE&LS provided construction inspection services as a prime on this design build contract. We provided the NICET IV Chief Engineer, Resident Engineer, one NICET IV Office Engineer, one NICET Level III inspector and two NICET Level II inspectors.
