



## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

RE&LS provided Structural Services for the World of Inquiry School No. 58. The school is a multi-level two/three-story building with a basement, and about 106,500 square feet of building area, constructed in 1915. The building rehabilitation scope of work for this facility included major structural alterations to reconfigure approximately 50,000 square feet of building area including the gymnasium, physical plant, penthouses, internal stairs and elevators.

Exterior rehabilitation work included complete window and exterior door replacement, rehabilitation and repairs to existing brick masonry, stone and precast. The exterior façade was also changed by the additions. A 60,000 square foot new classroom addition is proposed to transform this facility to a K – 12 school. A new two story entry space was constructed, opening from the lower level to a walk out terraced amphitheater.
