



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Rome Waterfront Village project was intended to foster the revitalization of the area between South James Street and Erie Boulevard north of the Erie Canal as well as improve public access to the canal. The development included the construction of a bulkhead and dock system within the Erie Canal as well as public walkways, seating areas, utility infrastructure, and stormwater management practices.

RE&LS performed Phase I ESA's to investigate the potential impact of several properties in the Rome Waterfront Village Infrastructure Improvement project. The Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA's) were on each of the two Sites within the Rome Waterfront Village project area. RE&LS performed also provided a third party review on the historical documents of the sites.
